Third Sector Foundation of Türkiye (TÜSEV) is delighted to host a three-day bootcamp, bringing together civil society professionals and communication experts from Türkiye and the Western Balkan countries (from North Macedonia, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Serbia, and Montenegro) supported by EU Technical Assistance to Civil Society Organisations in the Western Balkans and Turkey – EU TACSO 3. The regional bootcamp will take place from May 20-22, 2025, in Istanbul, Türkiye.

The bootcamp's primary goal is to foster dialogue and collaboration around reimagining civil society's reputation and developing innovative communication strategies. This dynamic and participatory bootcamp will provide a creative space for national and international participants to explore how civil society organizations can amplify their impact and best practices through hope-based communication approaches. - Build practical skills through interactive discussions, hands-on labs, creative campaigning methods, and case studies.
- Connect with a diverse group of professionals, fostering peer learning and collaboration at both national and international levels.
- Explore new approaches to communication and advocacy that inspire creativity and collective action.

### **Application criteria**


- Currently employed at a civil society or international organization in North Macedonia, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Serbia, or Montenegro.

- Holds a communication-focused position (e.g., Communication Expert, Specialist, or similar role) or a program officer/coordinator role with responsibilities for the organization's communication and reputation efforts.
- Committed to exploring and applying new communication strategies in their work.
- Eager to enhance their organization's reputation and visibility within their country and the broader region.
- Motivated to actively engage with and learn from international experts and peers.
- Able to participate in the three-day bootcamp on May 20-22, 2025, in Istanbul, Türkiye.
