

Mia Vukojević, Expert in Emergency Response

Mia Vukojević has 12 years of experience in humanitarian organizations including working for Oxfam Canada and Oxfam Great Britain, the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), and serving on the Board of Directors of the Sphere Project, Geneva. During her years at Oxfam and ICRC, among other crises, Mia was responsible for humanitarian responses to refugee crises in the Balkans, earthquakes in Pakistan, Haiti, and Zimbabwe, as well as the Canadian role in Oxfam International's response to the crises in Darfur, Sudan. Mia administered the training of staff and partners in emergency preparedness, humanitarian standards, gender in emergencies, and lead Oxfam's advocacy on humanitarian issues in Canada. Mia also has many years of experience as a trainer/facilitator of civil military relations and civil military cooperation courses.

Mia holds an MA from Carleton University's Institute of European and Russian Studies, Faculty of Public Administration and Management in Ottawa and is currently serving as the Program Director for the Rockefeller Brothers Fund's (RBF) Western Balkans Programme. Prior to her tenure with RBF, Mia has worked with Oak Foundation, OSCE's Special Monitoring Mission to Ukraine, and Trag Foundation in Serbia.
